Your job

Your job will be based within the Infrastructure Maintenance team and will be working with other Infrastructure Maintenance operatives

Supervising Street Lighting Operatives, you will work within the parameters of The Deal and the Accountable Teams initiative.

You will undertake all aspects of maintenance work for lighting columns, signs, bollards, guard rails, Christmas decorations and other installations including; electrical and structural testing and inspection, fault repairs and remedial works and installation and removal of street furniture.

You will attend emergency call outs, according to the standby rota, both during and outside working hours. This includes weekends and Public Holidays.
