The Oasis Information Technology Team gives Oasis Community Learning a strategic capability, supporting its mission of delivering exceptional education at the heart of the community.

The IT Team includes the wide range of skills and disciplines that are required to support a large and complex IT solution designed to enable the success of thousands of young people with different needs and requirements. One team, operating and managed nationally provides the service to local users and manages a shared infrastructure.

Combined, the team delivers a solution and service that is based on industry standard and sector leading technology that is far greater than the sum of its parts.

The Oasis IT Team is a great place to succeed, where everyone can make a difference, seeing the value of their work every day. A team that is big enough to have the scope to allow careers to develop in different directions whilst being small enough for an individual's creativity and initiative to be recognised.

Oasis IT Services Ltd.

Recognised as leaders in the sector, the Oasis IT Team not only provide services to the Oasis family of academies but also offers IT Services to other schools, academies and Multi-Academy Trusts. This gives the team lots of opportunities to be part of a broad range of projects, working within experienced delivery teams, deploying the latest technology into new, state of the art buildings.



Our Technology

Built on Cisco technology, the Oasis network spans over 50 locations across England, linking our academies together into a single centrally managed IT solution. Hosted out of our two national data centres and leveraging the power of the Microsoft cloud through Microsoft Azure and Microsoft Office 365, we provide an Enterprise IT solution to over 35,000 users.

The pair of Cisco Nexus switches manage the flow of traffic around our network, sharing the bandwidth delivered by our three MIA links between all our academies and offices. The estate wide Cisco Meraki Wireless solution allows authorised users to seamlessly move between sites and continue to access the resources they need.

Our team manage over 250 Microsoft Windows servers, within a Microsoft Hyper-V Virtualisation Environment, deploying a full range of Microsoft technologies including Microsoft System Centre Configuration Manager (SCCM), Microsoft System Centre Data Protection Manager (DPM), Microsoft System Centre Operations Manager (SCOM) and Microsoft System Centre Virtual Machine Manager (SCVMM).

With a mixture of client devices deployed across the estate, we manage the devices that allow our users to select the right solution for the job at hand. Microsoft Windows client devices can be used in conjunction with Apple iPads managed through our Jamf MDM platform.





Our Team

The Oasis IT Team operates across the country, as a single team made up of around 100 specialist technicians, engineers, project managers and service managers providing a full range of services to our academies.

Operating based on ITiL principles, the service delivery team supports our academies in clusters, operating across a number of academies in the local area in conjunction with the National Service Desk to provide incident and problem resolution along with request fulfilment for our users.

The web hosting of the 50 plus Oasis websites and the customisation of our Microsoft Office 365 environment is managed by the IT Development team. Building websites and applications to support the organisation helps to

ensure that we are able to leverage the maximum benefit from the technology that is deployed.

The Project Team oversee our capital project delivery function, supporting organisational change programmes along with the implementation of key new technology's and the integration of new academies into the IT System.

Our National Infrastructure Team manage and upgrade our critical shared infrastructure to make sure that the organisation remains secure and takes advantage of the latest technology available. Our on-premise Microsoft and Cisco infrastructure integrates through to our Virtual Private Microsoft Azure Data Centres

The Oasis IT Team is great place to work, provides a supportive and friendly working environment where everyone has the chance to make a difference to the lives of young people and the opportunity to succeed and develop professionally. In addition to the salary package, we offer:

A generous holiday allowance

When you join Oasis you receive 25 days annual leave in the first instance, plus bank holidays. This then rises to 30 days after 2 years of service, plus bank holidays.
