Monitor and assess pupils' results and progress, ensuring appropriate records are kept, and use the data to inform targets, lesson plans and differentiated schemes of work.		
Develop teaching and assessment materials.		
Prepare pupils for internal and external assessments.		
Assist with the administration of internal and external assessments.		
Meet with teachers to report on pupils' progress and educational needs.		
Contribute to development planning, evaluation and quality improvement processes.

Promote, develop and support the delivery of high quality PE teaching and learning within the school.
