Your apprenticeship

As a Leisure Team Member Apprentice, you will support, enhance and deliver the day to day operations and services of our Be Well facilities. Working as part of a team, you will be required to undertake a range of operational duties such as assisting with the opening and closing of the facility, undertaking routine maintenance of equipment and maintaining the cleanliness and safety of the environment. You will support programmed activities and take on duties including Lifeguard, Swimming Teacher, Gym Instructor and Group Activity Leader.

*Please be advised applicants will need to be able to prove their swimming ability at the interview stage.

The Be Well team are committed to support the health and wellbeing of our residents across the Wigan Borough. Whether this be supporting our youngest residents embark on their first swimming lesson or supporting individuals and community groups with existing exercise and wellbeing programmes. Shift patterns will vary, Monday to Friday, between 07.00am and 22:00pm. Weekend working is required on a rota basis, with equivalent time worked allocated as time off Monday to Friday.

During your apprenticeship you will

- Perform all the duties of a swimming teacher including; delivering swimming lessons that develop water confidence, core aquatic skills, safety and technical skills across a range of participants of different abilities from non-swimmer to advanced.
- Perform the duties of a lifeguard including; working as part of a team to provide safe supervision of swimmers and prevent accidents. How to intervene providing rescues and life saving techniques when necessary.
- Perform all of the duties of a gym instructor; including; conducting, gym inductions, client consultations, assessment and review and health screening.

- Plan activity sessions using techniques that are suitable for the participant(s) and their goals.
- Undertake pre-activity screening and health and safety checks when leading group sessions/classes.
- Lead groups using appropriate communication methods.
- Work in a team to support peers and colleagues to meet the goals of the business.
- Undertake the operational housekeeping of the leisure facility. For example, assembling, dismantling, routine maintenance and storage of equipment and cleaning tasks.
- Assist in the operation of opening and closing procedures, including evacuation. Safe set up of equipment and activities.
- Monitor customer use of equipment and ensure their safety, intervening, as necessary.
- You will be required to work evenings and weekends.
- You will be required to work across all Be Well Leisure Centres across the Borough.
- To provide assistance in the operation of events (both on and off site) as requested by management.
