As a Catholic school 'Jesus Christ is our family role model' and our mission to 'dream the impossible and achieve beyond our wildest imagination' is evident in our aspiration to be the best Catholic school possible for the good of our young people and the communities we serve. Fifty percent of our cohort are high ability learners capable of achieving the highest possible grades at GCSE. We also have over 20 students who are looked after in Bolton's Care homes. We are passionate about ensuring that all learners have the same opportunities to achieve at their best and we have a commitment to close the achievement gap with the 17.4% of students who are in receipt of the pupil premium grant. The number of disabled students and those who have an EHCP of Special Educational Needs is 22. The number supported by SEN Support is 44. It is our aspiration to provide a curriculum that is accessible to all. The vast majority of our learners are well organised and have a strong desire to do well. There are however, some students who have been crushed by their life experiences. Our mission is to mend their broken lives and give them a hope for a brighter future. This Deputy Headteacher role is pivotal in providing the structures and ensuring a consistency of high standards of discipline and behaviour, coupled with top quality learning and teaching to give these and all our learners the wings to fly.
