On an ongoing basis you will:

- Ensure you get yourself to work on time daily from the start of the apprenticeship
- Be prepared to travel between sites (within council vehicles) on a daily basis
- Assist qualified trades people in carrying out reactive and planned highway maintenance works, this will include:
 - Excavate, lay, and compact road construction materials
 - Assist in working to precise line, level and specification in laying drains, kerbs, flags, and blocks
 - Carry out repairs to the highway drainage, footways and carriageways
 - Operating construction plant, machinery, and power tools
 - To prepare, set up and work with temporary traffic management systems
- Ensure you follow health and safety guidelines and instructions
- Travel to and attend college on a weekly /regular basis, where you will undertake theoretical and practical exams and assessments.

- Compile the required portfolio of evidence of achievements to ensure successful yearly progression throughout your apprenticeship.
- Ensure you operate within GDPR guidelines by regularly reviewing data held and destroying information in line with retention schedules
