Job Title: Lunchtime Supervisor

Salary Scale: Band 3 – SCP 2

Responsible to: Senior Leadership Team / Senior Playleader

Main Functions: To assist the Senior Playleader and or Teaching & Support Staff under the direction of the Headteacher, for ensuring the safety, welfare and good conduct of pupils during breaks and or lunchtimes: -

Duties and Responsibilities

- To maintain order and the safe transfer of pupils to and from the dining area.
- To positively encourage good behaviour, table manners and hygiene.
- To assist younger pupils where necessary whilst they are taking a meal.
- To actively supervise the dining room procedures: -
 - carrying of meals to the table
 - assisting with the service at the table
 - training children in the correct use of cutlery
 - clearing and stacking table equipment and serving dishes
 - wiping and re-setting tables if necessary
 - cleaning up food and water spillages on tables and floors
- To undertake first aid training to allow the administration of first aid. To log/record all accidents in line with the school's first aid and record keeping/reporting policies.
- Be responsible for organising play activities in the playground or indoors if a wetplaytime.
- To liaise with the Headteacher/Senior Playleader/teaching staff or support staff in dealing with problems arising from pupil behaviour and any other matters of concern.
- To contribute as a member of a team to the ethos and environment of the school.
- To adhere to need for confidentiality at all times.
